**Declaration of Conformity to EU RoHS Directive**  
**Directive n° 2011/65/UE (RoHS II) and Directive n° 2015/863/UE (RoHS III)**

The Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive (**RoHS**) sets limits on the use of certain hazardous materials in new electrical and electronic equipment with the aim to protect human health and the environment. It also includes the ecologically correct recovery and disposal of electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) waste.

The below table lists the permitted substance maximum values by weight for steel products used in the manufacturing of electrical and electronic equipment:

- Lead (Pb): 0,1 %
- Mercury (Hg): 0,1 %
- Cadmium (Cd): 0,01 %
- Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI): 0,1 %
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB): 0,1 %
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE): 0,1 %
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): 0,1 %
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): 0,1 %
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): 0,1 %
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): 0,1 %

All products that are manufactured and placed on the market by O.R.I. MARTIN S.p.A. are in compliance with RoHS II and RoHS III Directives.
